# PALS TEAM COMMUNION

1ST SUNDAY OF EVERY MONTH (UMC & DOC): MATERIALS ARE UNDER THE COUNTER THAT DIVIDES THE KITCHEN AND DINING AREA ON THE KITCHEN SIDE.  
BREAD AND GRAPE JUICE NEED TO BE PURCHASED. CUT BREAD INTO CUBES WITHOUT CRUST.

POUR JUICE INTO DISPOSABLE CUPS USING WHITE DROPPER.

FOR DOC COMMUNION MONTHS: FOR ALL SUNDAYS AFTER THE 1ST, WE DO COMMUNION BY INTINCTION.

A FULL LOAF OF BREAD AND JUICE WILL NEED TO BE PURCHASED. THE FULL LOAF SHOULD LAST THE REST OF THE MONTH.

A CHUNK OF BREAD AND A CHALICE OF JUICE SHOULD BE PLACED ON THE ALTAR AND WILL BE OFFERED BY PASTOR AND PARISHIONER FOR THOSE WHO WISH AT THE END  
OF THE SERVICE.
